The shower chairs, which Cancer Services provides to clients free of charge, ensures the client's safety and allows them to reserve their energy. Shower chairs with a back rest are in demand because of the comfort level for cancer patients, however, Cancer Services will accept showers with or without a back rest.

Because of donors, Cancer Services was able to loan out 1,276 pieces of durable medical equipment to local families touched by cancer in 2017.
