Fundraising Walk Raises Money for Local People with Cancer

FORT WAYNE, IND. – Cancer Services of Northeast Indiana will hold the 2016 Lapper and Survivors Day Celebration on Saturday, May 14.

The Lapper is a fundraising walk benefitting Cancer Services. All of the money raised at the event stays in Northeast Indiana to help our friends and neighbors with cancer.

There are three ways to participate: 1) raise money and walk at the event, 2) make a donation or 3) become a sponsor. Many participants walk or donate in honor of a friend or loved one who has been touched by cancer.
