Rising Trends in Young Adult Cancer Diagnoses Leads to New Safe Spaces to Connect and Find Hope

Because of your support, Cancer Services is adding new programs like Compass to meet emerging needs

Receiving a cancer diagnosis in your 20s or 30s brings different challenges and struggles than getting a diagnosis in your 60s or 70s. Young adults who are building a career or starting a family and still finding their place in the world often have a very different experience with cancer.

According to the National Cancer Institute, nearly 85,000 adolescents and young adults will be diagnosed with cancer this year. This number has grown alarmingly within the past thirty years; a research study in BMJ Oncology found that cancer rates in people under 50 years old increased by 79.1% between 1990 and 2019.

Kaitlyn Pozorski, LCSW, who worked with many young adults at Cancer Services, noticed this concerning upward trend. "I was seeing an increase in young adults seeking counseling support and heard from my colleagues that they were working with more young adults too. In interactions with young adult clients, I kept hearing them express similar things - feeling alone, worried about how they were going to continue to work, finances, childcare, and body image."

It was important to Cancer Services to dig deeper and hear directly from young adults with cancer. To accomplish this, Cancer Services conducted a comprehensive young adult needs assessment. The process started with a survey asking young adults who have been impacted by cancer to answer questions about their experience, concerns, and unmet needs.

The survey results found:

- Young adults with cancer were primarily concerned with their physical health, finances, and mental health, in that order.
- Survey participants reported facing lack of childcare, struggling with the possibility
 of the end of their life and how their passing would impact their family, and not
 finding support groups that tackled the challenges in their stage of life.
- Over 60% of respondents wanted to participate in a program so they could connect with others in their situation.

Cancer Services followed up with a focus group of young adults to discuss their needs in greater detail. Connecting with others repeatedly came up during the conversation. They wanted a chance to talk to others who "get it," learn from each other, and help their peers who are just starting their journey.

Based on these findings, Cancer Services developed **Compass**, a series of programs developed for young adults touched by cancer. The first program, **Empowered Travelers**, provides a safe space for young adults to meet, connect, and help each other. Pozorski will facilitate the group.

"Our goal is that this will feel like a safe space for community and connection," Pozorski said about **Empowered Travelers** and other upcoming **Compass** offerings. "I hope young adults do not feel as alone during their cancer experience and feel they have others to connect with when navigating life after cancer."

Empowered Travelers will launch in June. Young adults who have been diagnosed with cancer are invited to attend.

In February, Cancer Services opened an additional location in Warsaw. This location has proven more convenient for people living in Kosciusko and some areas of Noble, Wabash, and Whitley counties. Meeting with an advocate face-to-face, having access to equipment and personal care supplies, and being able to attend group sessions closer to home are all benefits with cancer need who live beyond Allen County.

Julia is one of those people. She was in the middle of her first chemotherapy treatment when her husband Dan saw in InkFreeNews that Cancer Services had just opened a new location in Warsaw. The couple had never heard of us before but wanted to see how we could help. Julia and Dan visited on opening day and sat down with Client Advocate Taylor. Taylor listened as Julia shared her journey so far. She gave Julia a safe space to talk about her challenges and fears. That day, Julia received a cane, nutritional drink supplements, and a wig. Now she knows where to go when she needs help or some extra emotional support.

Since the location's opening, 56 people affected by cancer have been helped. In addition to emotional support from their client advocate, they have received practical assistance including equipment, personal care supplies, wigs, and financial help. Starting May 22, the first group sessions will begin on site with weekly Chair Yoga classes.
